


## Stop the tiger mosquito!




The tiger mosquito is day-active and very aggresive – and has arrived in our region. It can potentially transmit diseases. Tiger mosquitoes place their eggs and larvae in standing water. Therefore: no water or frequently changed water reduces its spread.



Avoid containers with standing water











Dispose of any rubbish immediately or keep it in a well covered container
